THE DYNAMIC RISK LOOP

A field card for the loop that runs continuously while the event is in motion — and the three decisions it can deliver.



WHERE TO POINT YOUR ATTENTION Four things to monitor	
ENVIRONMENT	Weather, terrain, water, light, traffic. Has anything moved outside what the RAS assumed?
GROUP	Energy, attention, behaviour, fitness. Who's holding up — and who isn't? Watch the quiet ones.
STAFF & KIT	Anyone unwell, separated, distracted? Comms working? Anything missing or broken the SOP needs?
YOURSELF	Are you tired, rushed, defensive? Your judgement is the instrument — check it like any kit.

- GOLDEN RULES**
- **Op Limits trigger first.** If a Red trigger fires, the call is already made — act.
 - **Say the call out loud.** "I'm calling Orange — we're moving the lunch stop."
 - **Gut feeling is data, not a verdict.** If something feels off, reassess properly.
 - **Cancelling is a successful outcome** if the reassessment said it should.
